This week second grade researched holidays around the world! Monday through Thursday, students rotated classrooms for the first half of the day and learned about differ-




The students in 5th grade have been enthusiastic about creating amazing decimal and water cycle projects in class.


skills in adding subtracting, multiplying and dividing decimals and understanding the water cycle and new vocabulary.














Specials: Computers

Ist grade students had fun on MS Paint this week. They drew a snowman by following the instructions.


2nd grade students wrote a holiday letter to present their lovely ones.





How to Submit pictures to be featured in the Yearbook!

Hello!

This year, submitting pictures to be considered for the yearbook is really easy.

- 1. Go to http://www.hjeshare.com/eShare/Index.jsp or search for HJ ESHARE in the app store (Apple and Android).
- 2. School Code: OSES2017 (case sensitive!)
- 3. Fill out the acknowledgement information.
- 4. Submit up to 10 pictures at a time. Once uploaded, you will be asked for the grade level of the student(s) in the picture. If it was a multi-grade event, such as Grandparents Night, just put K-2, 3-5, etc. If it is a single grade level, just put the number (1st grade = 1). It will also ask for the names of students and a brief description. If it is a class picture, you put "______'s Class" or "Grade Level." All fields must have something.

That's it! The deadline to submit pictures will be sometime in March. But please do not wait until the last minute, as I'd like to work on the book throughout the year.
